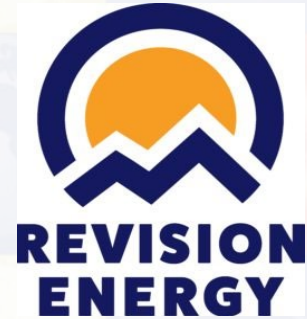

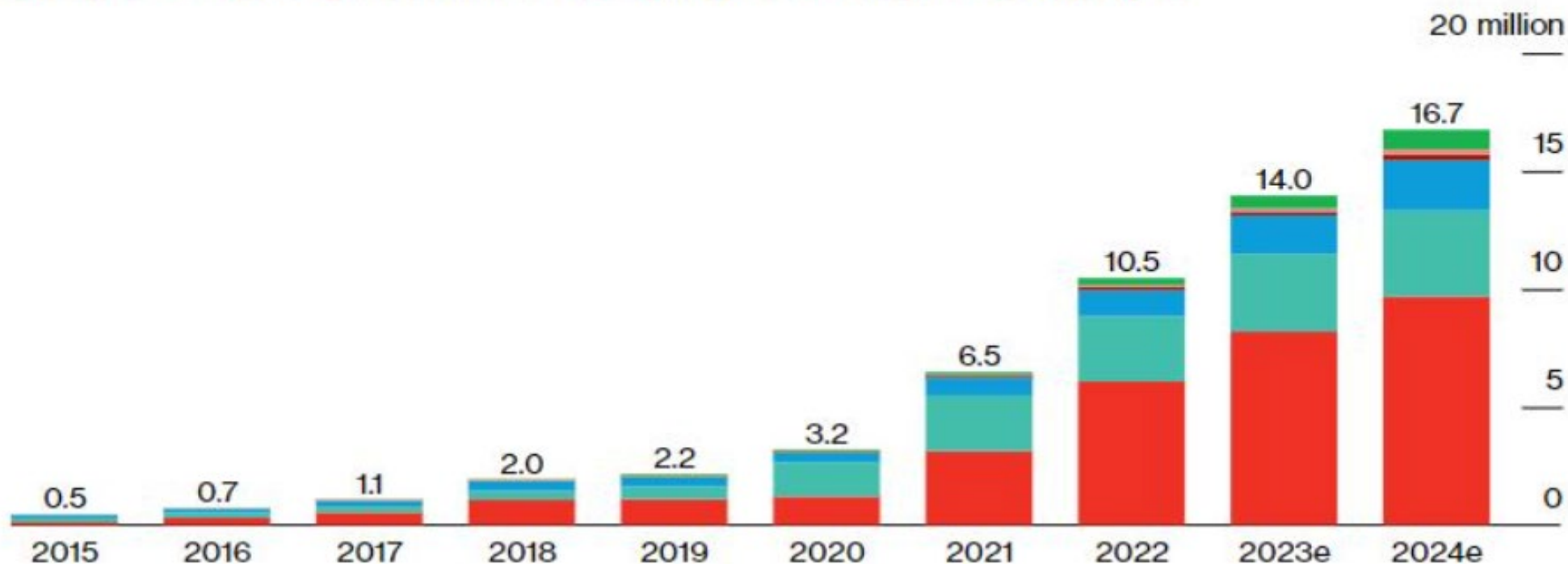


2024 Global EV sales estimated to grow 20% to top 17 Million: more than 60% sales are in China--BYD just overtook TESLA as the largest global EV company

Global Passenger EV Sales Will Top 16.7 Million in 2024

Number of new passenger electric vehicles sold annually

China Europe North America South Korea Japan Rest of World



Crossing many inflection points: 40 Mill EVs in use globally up from 26 Mill in 2022 (out of 1.5 Bill 2.6%). Norway is first country with more EVs than gas powered cars on the road with EVs as 90% of new cars sold & plans to eliminate ICE sales in 2025. China 38% of new car sales are EVs.

Our goal has been helping fleet managers to learn from each other & to share the best content we can find...but not sure fleet management is getting easier

- Significant funding, incentives & business models (e.g. low carbon fuel source credits)
- Many more vehicle and fuel options

- Supply chain issues (e.g., weather delays, foreign manufacturing delays)
- Challenges procuring some vehicles & parts in a timely way
- Navigating changing regulations & incentives
- Inflation (e.g., 42% increase in price for some commercial vehicles since 2020)
- Finding & managing talent (e.g., increasing wages)

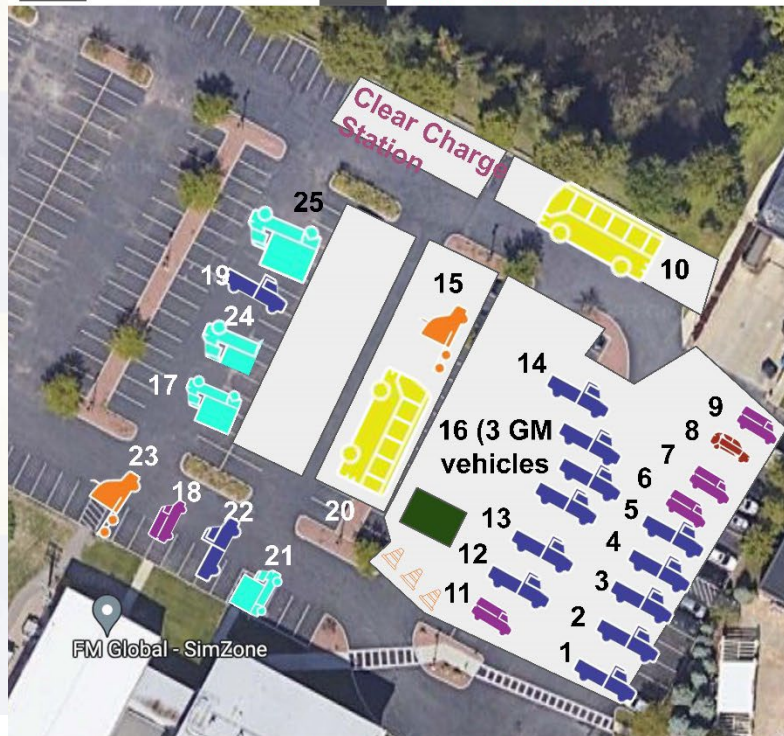
